AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER FOR THE BOROUGH OF PINE VALLEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSION OF THE BOROUGH OF PINE VALLEY IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A.9-140.1 et seq. the position of Chief Financial Officer of this municipality is hereby created. The term of office shall be for one (1) year.

SECTION 2. The Chief Financial Officer shall be a municipal finance officer who has been certified, as such, in accordance with the procedures, rules and regulations of the Division of Local Government Services of New Jersey. The position of Chief Financial Officer is created in order to carry out the responsibilities, duties and obligations set forth in N.J.S.A. 52:27BB-26 et seq.

SECTION 3. The Chief Financial Officer shall be compensated in accordance with the local municipal salary ordinance. Said Officer shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Commission.



EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication, in the manner prescribed by law.

The "Mutual Aid Operations Plan" promulgated by the Camden County Chiefs of Police Association proscribing the specifics of emergency reciprocal police assistance is hereby incorporated by reference without inclusion herein. Such "Mutual Aid Operations Plan" will be periodically updated; but such updated version will not be enacted until distributed to each and every party hereto for their edification and whatever action they may deem appropriate.
5. The Chief of Police shall annually, and as soon after the end of the year as practicable, furnish the respective governing body with a summary report of services rendered and received with his comments and recommendations.
