AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN AMENDED ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH
AN ENFORCEMENT AGENCY UNDER THE UNIFORM FIRE SAFETY ACT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Pine Valley had previously adopted an Amended Ordinance To Establish An Enforcement Agency Under The Uniform Fire Safety Act adopted on March 24, 1994 to have the Uniform Fire Safety Act enforced locally, and

WHEREAS, in the original Ordinance the Local Enforcing Agency shall be the Bureau of Fire Prevention of the Pine Hill Fire Company #1 of the Municipality of Pine Hill, New Jersey, and

WHEREAS, a fire official is needed to enforce the Uniform Fire Code and will be appointed for a term of three years, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that Section 2 of the original Ordinance be changed to read as follows:


The Local Enforcing Agency shall be the Bureau of Fire Prevention of the Borough of Pine Valley, New Jersey and that a fire official be appointed to enforce the Uniform Fire Safety Act for a term of three years.
