

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL COURT OF
THE BOROUGH OF PINE VALLEY, CAMDEN
COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Commission of the
Borough of Pine Valley, County of Camden and State of New
Jersey:

Section 1. A municipal court for the Borough
of Pine Valley is hereby established pursuant to the provisions
of N.J.S. 2A:8-1 as amended and supplemented.

Section 2. The name of the municipal court shall
be "Municipal Court of the Borough of Pine Valley".

Section 3. The municipal court shall have a seal
which shall bear the impress of the name of the court.

Section 4. There shall be a municipal court Judge
of said municipal court who shall be appointed by the Borough Com-
mission and who shall serve for a term of three years from the
date of his appointment and until his successor is appointed and
qualified.

Section 5. The municipal court Judge shall receive
an annual salary in the amount of \$250.00 , payable December
. Such annual salary shall be in lieu of any and all
other fees.

Section 6. Said municipal court and the municipal
court Judge thereof shall have, possess and exercise all functions,
powers, duties and jurisdiction conferred by the provisions of
N.J.S. 2A:8-1 as amended and supplemented or by any other law.
et-seq.

Section 7. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon due passage and publication according to law.
