AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PINE VALLEY IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO ESTABLISH A POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PINE VALLEY, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

SECTION 1

That the Borough of Pine Valley establish a full-time police department which shall furnish 24 hour police protection. The police department shall consist of a chief of police and such members, officers, and personnel as the Borough Council deems necessary.

SECTION 2

That the chief of police shall be the head of the police department and he shall be directly responsible to the Borough Council for the efficient day-to-day operation of said department and shall faithfully discharge all duties required by law, including, but not limited to those set forth in N.J.S. 40A:14-118.

SECTION 3

This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
